Features of the platform

1 ABOUT / MŌ TE AHA

Recaps what each of the buttons do, and how to navigate the pop-up windows.



2 ADD DATA / TĀPIRI RAURANGA

Where you can add more marine and coastal data layers to the map. These layers can be from Kōrero Takutai, your own data, or something you have found on the internet.



3 LEGEND / WHAKAMŌHIO MAPI

Opens up the map legend to show what is being displayed currently. Especially helpful if you are displaying a lot of layers at once. This is open by default when you open Kōrero Takutai.



4 FULL SCREEN / MATA ROROHIKO NUI

Displays the map in full-screen mode, hiding the panel of text on the left hand side, and the tabs along the top. Click this again to return to the default view.



5 MAP OVERVIEW / TIRO WHANUI MAPI

Displays a small map showing the location of the current map extent. Can be useful when zoomed in at a small scale to show the wider context of your location. Click again to hide the overview.



6 SEARCH BAR / RAPUA

Searches for locations or application areas. Enter your search term and then click on the result to navigate to the location.



7 LAYER LIST / RĀRANGI APA

Customises what you can see on your basemap. The check-boxes next to each layer name turn the layer on or off.



8 PRINT CURRENT VIEW / TUHI MĀTUHA

Prints what you are looking at on the screen. Choose the layout and format that you want to print in, and then press 'Print'. Caution: if you have too much data in your map, it might not print properly.




9 SELECT TOOL / KŌWHIRI

Selects information within a specific area. It shows a list of selectable layers, and a range of methods to select them. Once you have drawn your selecting shape, the list of layers will update to let you know how many things have been selected in each layer. Clicking on the three dots gives you some optional extras for the selected data in each layer.



10 MEASURE TOOL / MĒHUA

Measures points, lines and areas. The point measurement will show you the coordinates for your point marker.



11 QUERY TOOL / UI

Narrows down what data is displayed within a layer. You can select a specific application area to show.



12 DRAW TOOL / TUHI

Lets you draw on the map, and add it to the list of layers. You can also add text, change the colour and other formatting.



13 CHANGE BASEMAP / MAPI MATUA

Changes what the map of New Zealand looks like. It provides a selection of different basemap options, including topographic and aerial imagery.



14 FILTER / TĀTARI

Filters layers based on expressions defined by the user, using SQL language.



15 VIEW DATA TABLE / RIPANGA RARAUNGA

Shows the qualitative information for the shapes being displayed on screen. This is where you can see the information displayed in the popups, for more than one feature at once.



16 ZOOM IN/OUT / TOPA MAI/ATU

Zoom into the map using the plus button. Zoom out using the minus button.



17 DEFAULT EXTENT / TIROHANGA TAUNOA

Returns the map to its original zoom level, which is the level when first opened.



18 MY LOCATION / TAKU TAUWĀHI

Zooms the map to your current location. Note that you will need to enable relevant location services for this to work.
