#### **DEFINITIONS OF EACH COLLECTIVE GROUP**

1. For the purposes of clause 1.5-1.8:

#### Ngati Ngararanui

- 1.1 Ngati Ngararanui (including Ngati Tamahika and Ngati Tuteaiti):
  - 1.1.1 means the collective group composed of:
    - (a) individuals descended from one or more Ngati Ngararanui Ancestors; and
    - (b) individuals who are members of the subgroups referred to in paragraph 1.1.3(a); and
  - 1.1.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.1.1; and
  - 1.1.3 includes the following subgroups:
    - (a) Ngati Tamahika and Ngati Tuteaiti; and
    - (b) any iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.1.1;
- 1.2 Ngati Ngararanui Ancestor means an individual who:
  - 1.2.1 exercised Customary Rights by virtue of being descended from: Ngararanui, Tuteaiti or Tamahika; and
  - 1.2.2 exercised the Customary Rights predominantly in relation to the Area of Interest at any time after 6 February 1840;

#### Ngati Kearoa Ngati Tuara

- 1.3 Ngati Kearoa Ngati Tuara:
  - 1.3.1 means the collective group composed of:
    - (a) individuals descended from one or more Ngati Kearoa Ngati Tuara Ancestors; and
    - (b) individuals who are members of the subgroups referred to in paragraph 1.3.3(a); and



- 1.3.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.3.1; and
- 1.3.3 includes the following subgroups:
  - (a) Ngati Kearoa, Ngati Kokohu and Ngati Tuara; and
  - (b) any iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.3.1;
- 1.4 **Ngati Kearoa Ngati Tuara Ancestor** means an individual who:
  - 1.4.1 exercised Customary Rights by virtue of being descended from Kearoa or Tuara; and
  - 1.4.2 exercised the Customary Rights predominantly in relation to the Area of Interest at any time after 6 February 1840;

#### Ngati Tura – Ngati Te Ngakau

- 1.5 Ngati Tura – Ngati Te Ngakau:
  - 1.5.1 means the collective group composed of:
    - (a) individuals descended from one or more Ngati Tura-Ngati Te Ngakau Ancestors; and
    - (b) · individuals who are members of the subgroups referred to in paragraph 1.5.3(a); and
  - 1.5.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.5.1; and
  - 1.5.3 includes the following subgroups:
    - Ngati Tura and Ngati Te Ngakau; and (a)
    - any iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, (b) hapu, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.5.1;
- 1.6 Ngati Tura - Ngati Te Ngakau Ancestor means an individual who:
  - 1.6.1 exercised Customary Rights by virtue of being descended from Tura or Te Ngakau; and
  - 1.6.2 exercised the Customary Rights predominantly in relation to the Area of Interest at any time after 6 February 1840;



#### Ngati Te Roro o Te Rangi

#### 1.7 Ngati Te Roro o Te Rangi:

- 1.7.1 means the collective group composed of individuals descended from one or more Ngati Te Roro o Te Rangi Ancestors; and
- 1.7.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.7.1; and
- 1.7.3 includes any iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.7.1;

#### 1.8 **Ngati Te Roro o Te Rangi Ancestor** means an individual who:

- 1.8.1 exercised Customary Rights by virtue of being descended from Te Roro o Te Rangi; and
- 1.8.2 exercised the Customary Rights predominantly in relation to the Area of Interest at any time after 6 February 1840;

#### Ngati Tuteniu

#### 1.9 Ngati Tuteniu:

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- 1.9.1 means the collective group composed of individuals descended from one or more Ngati Tuteniu Ancestors; and
- 1.9.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.9.1; and
- 1.9.3 includes any iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.9.1;

#### 1.10 **Ngati Tuteniu Ancestor** means an individual who:

- 1.10.1 exercised Customary Rights by virtue of being descended from Tuteniu; and
- 1.10.2 exercised the Customary Rights predominantly in relation to the Area of Interest at any time after 6 February 1840;

#### Ngati Uenukukopako

#### 1.11 Ngati Uenukukopako:

1.11.1 means the collective group composed of:

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- (a) individuals descended from one or more Ngati Uenukukopako Ancestors; and
- (b) individuals who are members of the subgroups referred to in paragraph 1.11.3(a); and
- 1.11.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.11.1; and
- 1.11.3 includes the following subgroups:
  - (a) Ngati Hauora and Ngati Te Kanawa; and
  - (b) any iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.11.1;
- 1.12 Ngati Uenukukopako Ancestor means an individual who:
  - 1.12.1 exercised Customary Rights by virtue of being descended from Uenukukopako; and
  - 1.12.2 exercised the Customary Rights predominantly in relation to Whakapoungakau 8-16 at any time after 6 February 1840;

#### Tuhourangi Ngati Wahiao

- 1.13 **Tuhourangi Ngati Wahiao**:
  - 1.13.1 means the collective group composed of:
    - (a) individuals descended from one or more Tuhourangi Ngati Wahiao Ancestors; and
    - (b) individuals who are members of the subgroups referred to in paragraph 1.13.3(a); and
  - 1.13.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.13.1; and
  - 1.13.3 includes the following subgroups:
    - (a) Ngati Apumoana, Ngati Hinemihi, Ngati Hinganoa, Ngati Huarere, Ngati Kahu Upoko, Ngati Puta, Ngati Taoi, Ngati Te Apiti, Ngati Tionga, Ngati Tumatawera, Ngati Tuohonoa and Ngati Uruhina; and
    - (b) any iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.13.1;



- 1.14 **Tuhourangi Ngati Wahiao Ancestor** means an individual who:
  - 1.14.1 exercised Customary Rights by virtue of being descended from Tuhourangi; and
  - 1.14.2 exercised the Customary Rights predominantly in relation to Rotomahana Parekarangi 6 or Whakarewarewa 2 at any time after 6 February 1840;

Ngati Tahu – Ngati Whaoa

- 1.15 Ngati Tahu Ngati Whaoa:
  - 1.15.1 means the collective group composed of:
    - (a) individuals descended from one or more Ngati Tahu Ngati Whaoa Ancestors; and
    - (b) individuals who are members of the subgroups referred to in paragraph 1.15.3(a); and
  - 1.15.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.15.1; and
  - 1.15.3 includes the following subgroups:
    - (a) Ngati Hinewai, Ngati Karaka, Ngati Maru, Ngati Mataarae, Ngati Ngarangi, Ngati Pareauru, Ngati Rahurahu, Ngati Ruha and Ngati Te Rama; and
    - (b) any iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.15.1;
- 1.16 **Ngati Tahu Ngati Whaoa Ancestor** means an individual who:
  - 1.16.1 exercised Customary Rights by virtue of being descended from Tahu or Whaoa; and
  - 1.16.2 exercised the Customary Rights predominantly in relation to the Area of Interest at any time after 6 February 1840;

Ngati Pikiao (excluding Ngati Makino)

- 1.17 Ngati Pikiao (excluding Ngati Makino):
  - 1.17.1 means the collective group composed of:
    - (a) individuals descended from one or more Ngati Pikiao Ancestors; and



- (b) individuals who are members of the subgroups referred to in paragraph 1.17.3(a); and
- 1.17.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.17.1; and
- 1.17.3 includes the following subgroups:
  - (a) Ngati Tamateatutahi, Ngati Kawiti, Ngati Te Rangiunuora, Ngati Hinekura, Ngati Te Takinga, Ngati Tutaki-a-Hani, Ngati Tutaki-a-Koti, Ngati Paruaharanui, Ngati Hinerangi and Ngati Whakahemo; and
  - (b) any whanau, hapu or group of individuals composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.17.1;
- 1.18 Ngati Pikiao Ancestor means an individual who:
  - 1.18.1 exercised Customary Rights by virtue of being descended from Pikiao; and
  - 1.18.2 exercised the Customary Rights predominantly in relation to the Area of Interest at any time after 6 February 1840;

#### Ngati Rongomai

#### 1.19 Ngati Rongomai:

- 1.19.1 means the collective group composed of individuals descended from one or more Ngati Rongomai Ancestors; and
- 1.19.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.19.1; and
- 1.19.3 includes any iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.19.1;
- 1.20 **Ngati Rongomai Ancestor** means an individual who:
  - 1.20.1 exercised Customary Rights by virtue of being descended from Rakeiao;
  - 1.20.2 exercised the Customary Rights predominantly in relation to the Area of Interest at any time after 6 February 1840; and

#### Ngati Tarawhai

#### 1.21 Ngati Tarawhai:

1.21.1 means the collective group composed of:



- (a) individuals descended from one or more Ngati Tarawhai Ancestors; and
- (b) individuals who are members of the subgroup referred to in paragraph 1.21.3(a); and
- 1.21.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.21.1; and
- 1.21.3 includes the following subgroups:
  - (a) Ngati Hinemihi and Ngati Hinehua; and
  - (b) any iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapu, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.21.1; and
- 1.22 Ngati Tarawhai Ancestor means an individual who:
  - 1.22.1 exercised Customary Rights by virtue of being descended from Tarawhai; and
  - 1.22.2 exercised the Customary Rights predominantly in relation to the Area of Interest at any time after 6 February 1840.

#### **DEFINITION OF CUSTOMARY RIGHTS**

- 2. For the purposes of paragraph 1 above:
- 2.1 **Customary Rights** means rights according to the Affiliate Te Arawa lwi/Hapu tikanga, including:
  - 2.1.1 to occupy land in the Area of Interest; and
  - 2.1.2 in relation to the use of:
    - (a) land; or
    - (b) other natural or physical resources; and
- 2.2 a person is descended from another person if the first person is descended from the other by:
  - 2.2.1 birth;
  - 2.2.2 legal adoption; or
  - 2.2.3 Maori customary adoption in accordance with Te Arawa tikanga, being a blood child of a beneficiary of the Affiliate Te Arawa lwi/Hapu.
