We write to confirm the Crown's recognition of the mandate of Taumata Wiiwii Trust (the Trust) to negotiate a settlement of the historical Treaty claims of Ngāti Hauā and Ngāti Korokī Kahukura with the Crown.

The deed of mandate you have submitted shows that an open and transparent process was followed. We have concluded that the Trust is an appropriate body to represent Ngāti Hauā and Ngāti Korokī Kahukura in settlement negotiations with the Crown.
