As officials from the Office of Treaty Settlements have discussed with you, to the extent people who affiliate to Tangata Marae whakapapa to a Ngāti Hinerangi tūpuna, they will be covered by the Deed of Mandate and can be beneficiaries of a Ngāti Hinerangi settlement if they register with the Post-Settlement Governance Entity for Ngāti Hinerangi.

Please find attached the agreed Terms of Negotiation signed on behalf of the Crown for the Trust's countersigning.

Congratulations on attaining a Crown recognised mandate. We look forward to working with you further during negotiations.
