**Te Komiti Nui o Ngāti Whakaue - Refresh Mandate Hui
Ngāti Whakaue Treaty Settlement Negotiations**

Te Komiti Nui o Ngāti Whakaue (TKN) is seeking to refresh its Mandate (originally given in 2010) to re-engage with the Crown to complete negotiations for Ngāti Whakaue’s outstanding historical Treaty of Waitangi claims.

TKN invites all Ngāti Whakaue members to attend a hui near you or join livestream to the hui held in our whare tipuna Tamatekapua, Te Papaouru Marae Saturday 27 July 2024 10am to share your whakaaro and have your vote.

Purpose & Resolution

The purpose of these hui is to secure broad support from Ngāti Whakaue for the resolution: ‘that Te Komiti Nui o Ngāti Whakaue has a fresh mandate to re-enter negotiations with the Crown to secure a comprehensive settlement of all Ngāti Whakaue extant historical Treaty of Waitangi claims’

Presentation

Te Komiti Nui will give a presentation, including handouts of the presentation, that shows Ngāti Whakaue’s journey to settlement to date.

Following the presentation, you will have the opportunity to korero (Q&A) directly with your TKN representatives.

To conclude, all Ngāti Whakaue members in attendance will be asked to vote on the mandate resolution.

Voting

All Ngāti Whakaue members in attendance, 18 years or older can cast a vote

Vote will be by show of hands at the hui

Result of voting will be announced at the conclusion of each hui.
