Thank you for submitting the Te Atiawa lwi Authority Deed of Mandate to the Crown to negotiate a comprehensive settlement of all Te Atiawa (Taranaki) historical Treaty claims.

We have concluded that the Te Atiawa lwi Authority (TAIA) has the support of nga uri o Te Atiawa (Taranaki) and is an appropriate body to represent Te Atiawa (Taranaki) in settlement negotiations with the Crown.

We are therefore pleased to recognise the mandate of TAIA to represent nga uri o Te Atiawa (Taranaki) in negotiations for the settlement of all their historical Treaty claims.

There were several issues raised in the submissions received by the Office of Treaty Settlements on TAIA's Deed of Mandate. Officials will contact you shortly to discuss how to best address these issues in the period leading up to commencing formal negotiations. None of the issues raised, however, preclude us from recognising TAIA's mandate.

We are pleased with the progress made to date and look forward to signing Terms of Negotiation with you on 17 March at Owae Marae.
